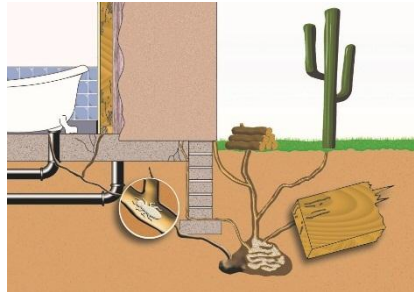
Termites can be the most threatening pests for home owners/buyers. Though there are a lot of different varieties of termite species out there, they all seem to do one common thing, and that is destroy!

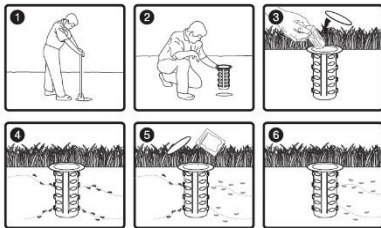

Termite Inspection Checklist



- *Check the foundation of your house. They will also check for mud tunnels and tubes coming from the soil to the structures*
- *Inspect windows, door frames, air conditioning systems, gas pipes and electrical lines for any type of termite activity.*
- *Closely look at areas where there are moist plants, especially plants that are located near to your house.*
- *Examine all areas that the house owners seem to suspect or be concerned of termite activity.*
- *Check for any plumbing and/or pipe leaks.*
